ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 21.09.2015 seeking information regarding action taken on his letter dated 08.07.2015, 30.10.2015 including copy of order, if passed for proper disposal of his letters, clarification/confirmation with regard to earlier reply to his earlier RTI application etc.

2. The CPIO responded on 13.10.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 26.10.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 02.12.2015. The appellant filed appeal on 29.02.2016 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The respondent participated in the hearing. The appellant did not participate in the hearing.

4. The respondent stated that the appellant has been replied to vide letter dated 13.10.2015. The respondent stated that it is beyond the jurisdiction and scope of the duties of the CPIO under the RTI Act to interpret the law, to

give explanation, opine, comment or advise on matters. The respondent stated that the appellant has been informed that SLP (C) No. 18 of 2010 was dismissed vide order dated 17.09.2013 and the appellant was not party in the said matter. The respondent stated that the appellant further informed that he may obtain copy of the judicial record on payment of prescribed fee as per Supreme Court Rules 2013 which is available on Supreme Court website www.sci.nic.in.

5. The respondent stated that the first appellate authority vide its order dated 02.12.2015 had disposed of the first appeal having concurred with the findings of the CPIO.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory. It is observed that this Commission has already dealt with the matter at hand vide order dated CIC/CC/A/2015/002260 dated 14.09.2016.

Decision:

7. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
