**ORDER**

1. Shri C.P. Rai filed an application dated 02.09.2013 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Central Information Commission (CIC) seeking information on seven points including (1) number of applications/appeals received and dismissed since the establishment of CIC year-wise, (2) number of cases in which penalty

has been imposed for violation of Section 7(1) of the RTI Act and as defined under Section 20 of the RTI Act and (iii) number of complaints received in the Commission against the working of Information Commissioners and action taken in the matter.

**2.** The appellant filed second appeal dated 11.03.2014 before the Commission on the grounds that incomplete, incorrect and misleading information was provided by the CPIO. The appellant states that if the PIO has provided incorrect, incomplete or misleading information, he must be penalized so that other PIOs should take a lesson and provide correct and complete information within the stipulated period.

**Hearing:**

**3.** The appellant Shri C.P. Rai was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri A.K. Sharma, CPIO, CIC was present in person.

**4.** The respondent submitted that point wise information was provided to the appellant by the respondent vide letter dated 30.09.2013. The respondent further submitted that information on point no. 1 of the RTI application with regard to appeals/complaints admitted and disposed of since April 2013 to September 2013 was also provided to the appellant during the hearing of the first appeal before the FAA.

**Decision:**

**5.** The Commission, after hearing the respondent and perusing the records, observes that due information has been provided to the appellant by the respondent. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

**6.** With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
