ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 04.11.2014 seeking information regarding copy of rules/regulations/benchmarks for allotments of shops at railway stations, details of shops and its occupants, details of pending recovery of rent etc.

2. The CPIO responded on 24.11.2014. The appellant filed first appeal on 02.01.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 19.01.2015. The appellant filed appeal on 06.04.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.

4. The appellant stated that the information with reference to point no. iv to viii and xi to xv of clause 4(1)(b) of the RTI Act has not been displayed by the respondent on their website.

5. The respondent stated that the all department's information is available on Railway Board's website. The respondent stated that Zonal Office and Railway Board has their official website but division office has no official

website. The respondent stated that it is possible that some information which is not available on zonal office website may be available on Railway Board's website. The respondent stated that the appellant has asked general information if he had asked specific information which is not available on their website, they would have provided it.

6. The appellant stated that he had sought allotment of shops rule but he has been provided refreshment policy.

7. The respondent stated that the refreshment has inter alia contained allotment rules also. The respondent stated that they will provide relevant extract of allotment rules.

8. The appellant stated that area of the shops was not provided to him.

9. The respondent stated that name and list of allottee was given but area was not available that time, they will provide the area of the shops.

10. The appellant stated that the utilization of income received from the occupants of shops has not been provided to him.

11. The respondent stated that the revenue goes in to the consolidated fund of India and at the local level they are not authorised to use the fund. They will inform this position to the appellant.

Discussion/ observation:

12. In view of the above facts, the remaining information can be provided to the appellant.

Decision:

13. The respondent is directed to provide remaining information to the appellant in the context of his RTI application, within 30 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
