ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 20.06.2014 seeking information regarding name of the officials responsible for keeping appellant case pending and copy of order pertaining to action taken against officials and name of official responsible for ordering an irregular recovery relating to his TA bill etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 01.07.2014 and 24.07.2014. The appellant filed first appeal dated 20.09.2014. The FAA responded on 11.11.2014. The appellant filed second appeal on 04.04.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. Appellant was absent. Respondent was represented through his counsel, who was personally present in the hearing.

4. Respondent stated that information sought by the appellant in his RTI application dated 20.06.2014 relates to service matter. They have provided full information to the appellant vide CPIO reply dated 24.07.2014. In fact, as the appellant has filed several RTI's on this issue, this information has been given many times.

Discussion/ observation:

5. The Commission observed that the sought for information has been already supplied by the respondent against the RTI application. Commission further observed that appellant in his second appeal has not indicated any deficiency in the response of the respondent in term of providing of information. He has in fact repeatedly referred to delay in a decision in his case, an issue which is not a matter for consideration of this Commission.

Decision:

6. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter. The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
