ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 03.07.2014 seeking information as to whether process for recruitment of law assistant has been completed; why the appellant has been rejected etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 12.08.2014. The appellant filed first appeal dated 29.08.2014, with First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 07.10.2014. The appellant filed second appeal on 27.04.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant participated in the hearing. The respondent did not participate in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that he had applied in the year 2010 for the post of law assistant. The appellant stated that after 4 years he has been informed that his application was received date and thus he was not entitled to appear in exam. The appellant stated that he wants to know the basis of rejection and date of receipt of his application. The appellant stated the

communication by which he was informed about rejection of his application is an undated letter. The appellant stated that he wants a copy of register in which the applications of the candidates were registered.

Discussion/ observation:

5. The reasons for delayed reply regarding rejection and copy of application receipt register may be provided to the appellant.

Decision:

6. The respondent is directed to provide information as stated in para 5 above within 30 days of this order, free of cost, to the appellant.

7. The respondent is directed to show cause why action should not be taken against them for contravening the provision of the RTI Act including not attending the hearing, within 30 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
