ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 17.09.2015 seeking information regarding: 1) the certified copies of application form sent by the candidates for the post of packer in sub-post office, Pali; 2) certified copy of the envelopes vide which 21 candidates have sent their application form; 3) certified copy of the inspection conducted by the Supdt., Northern Up Mandal in the year 2010; 4) certified copy of letter dated 1.4.2010 sent to Supdt. of Police, Hardoi relating to police verification report in respect of Shri Neeraj Trivedi.
2. The CPIO responded on 13.10.2015. The appellant filed first appeal dated 28.10.2015 with First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded through an undated letter. The appellant filed second appeal on 05.05.2016 before the Commission on the ground that no information has been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. Both the parties participated in the hearing through video conferencing.

4. The appellant stated that the respondent had provided misleading information to him.

5. On point 1, 2 and 4 of the RTI application as referred to in para 1 above, the respondent stated that they have denied the information u/s 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act being third party information. On point 3, the respondent stated that record has been weeded out.

Discussion/Observation:

6. The respondent should provide to the appellant proof of destruction of record within 15 days of receipt of this order.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to take action as per para 6.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
