ORDER

Facts:

Appeal No.CIC/BS/A/2015/001324

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 11.04.2015 seeking information on 3 points with regard to (i) Monthly details of the tax deduction for the FY 2013-14 and 2014-15 on the commission earned by his daughter who is a R.D. agent, (ii) Monthly details pertaining to deposit of the deducted tax along with challan and (iii) details of the tax due along with name and designation of the clerk/officer concerned.

2. The CPIO responded on 16.04.2015 stating that RTI application dated 11.04.2015 has been forwarded to the concerned CPIO. The appellant filed first appeal dated 14.05.2015 before the first appellate authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal to the Commission on 01.07.2015 on the ground that information should be provided to him.

3. The appellant filed RTI application dated 27.06.2015 seeking information on 6 points with regard to (i) Certified copy of reply dated 18.05.2015 pertaining to letter dated 15.06.2015, (ii) Certified copy the details of tax deduction on commission earned by his daughter on R.D. accounts for the FY 2013-14 and 2014-15, (iii) To furnish Form 16, if issued to his daughter, (iv) Certified copy of Bank challans, etc.

4. The CPIO responded on 15.06.2015. The appellant filed first appeal dated 03.08.2015 before the first appellate authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal to the Commission on 08.10.2015 on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

5. Both the parties participated in the hearing through video conferencing.

6. The appellant stated that he has not yet received the Form 16.

7. The respondent stated that earlier the same matter was heard in the Commission on 03.03.2017 in appeal no. CIC/BS/A/2015/002095. The respondent further stated that they have complied with the Commission's above order and sent Form 16 to the appellant and it will reach to him in due course of time. Other parts of the orders shall also be complied with.

Discussion/ observation:

8. The Commission is of the view that earlier order dated 03.03.2017 in appeal no. CIC/BS/A/2015/002095 should be complied with.

Decision:

9. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter.

The appeals are disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
