ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 09.03.2015 seeking information on 5 points regarding notification/order from the competent authority about the delay from the scheduled hours in commencing the Law paper of written examination for UPHJS-2014 held on 15.11.2014 and change in mode of main written examination etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 27.11.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 28.12.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 18.02.2016. The appellant filed second appeal on 18.05.2016 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The respondent participated in the hearing. The appellant did not participate in the hearing.
4. The respondent stated that the appellant has sought for the information with regard to written examination for UPHJS-2014 held on

15.11.2014 which was dealt with by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad. Hence, the appellant's RTI application was transferred u/s 6(3) of the RTI Act to the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad. The respondent stated that the Allahabad High Court replied to the RTI application on 27.11.2015.

Discussion/ observation:

5. From the perusal of the record, it appears that High Court of Judicature at Allahabad replied to the RTI application on 27.11.2015. The first appellate authority vide its order dated 12.02.2016 had disposed of the first appeal having concurred with the findings of the CPIO.

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

7. No action is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
