ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 25.02.2016 seeking information; whether any intimation has been received by respondent from the Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra Mumbai with regard to respondent's letter dated 27.01.2016.
2. The CPIO responded on 15.03.2016. The appellant filed first appeal on 23.03.2016 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 11.05.2016. The appellant filed second appeal on 23.06.2016 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that his grievance/complaint was wrongly forwarded to the Chief Secretary, State of Maharashtra. He had complained against the Chairman, National Commission for Scheduled Castes for not looking into his promotion in the Sangli District Central Co-operative Bank Ltd., even though he was at serial no. 1 in the seniority list. The appellant

stated that he is seeking the report received from the Government of Maharashtra.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letter dated 15.03.2016 was informed that his grievance was forwarded to the Chief Secretary, State of Maharashtra vide letter dated 27.01.2016 for appropriate action and no report has been received.

6. The respondent stated that the first appellate authority vide its order dated 11.05.2016 had disposed of the first appeal having concurred with the findings of the CPIO.

Discussion/ observation:

7. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

8. Respondent is directed to immediately forward the appellant's complaint to the Secretary, Ministry of Social Justice and the Secretary, Ministry of Finance Government of India for appropriate action by them within one month.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
