ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 10.02.2016 (copy of the RTI application is not on record) seeking information with reference to his earlier RTI applications with regard to allotment of land.
2. The CPIO responded on 19.02.2016. The appellant filed first appeal on 20.04.2016 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal on 28.06.2016 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that he has not been provided the information sought by him. The appellant stated that he is seeking information relating to the land allotment. The appellant stated that the all land is in the name of Hon'ble President of India hence, the respondent can call the record from the state and the sought for information can be provided to him. The appellant stated that he has been pursuing the land related matter since

1969 but neither District Collector nor other officer has ever redressed his grievances. The appellant stated that earlier, this commission has forwarded his matter to the Chief Secretary , but no information has been given to him.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letter dated 19.02.2016 was informed that the sought for information is not available with Hon'bl President Office and the matter relates to the State Government. The respondent stated that earlier this Commission has decided the appellant's matter on the issue at hand vide its order dated 4.01.2016, 09.02.2016 and 23.08.2016.

Discussion/ observation:

5. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

7. No action is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

8. The Chief Secretary, Government of Rajasthan is advised look in to the matter.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
