ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 12.11.2012, 03.01.2013 seeking information regarding copy of his Service Record, Share Certificate issued by the Central Railway Co-operative Society, Provident Fund Record etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 01.02.2013, 04.01.2013. The appellant filed first appeal on 05.03.2013 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 12.04.2013. The appellant filed second appeal on 21.01.2014 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing through VC. The appellant was represented by his daughter.
4. The appellant stated that he had been service in for 28 years with the Railways. He has not been given any service benefits. The appellant stated that he does not have service records. The appellant stated that he has only

an Identity Card. The appellant stated that he has not been provided the sought for information.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant has been replied to vide letters dated 04.01.2013, 12.04.2013. The respondent stated that the appellant is seeking information that is 21 years old. The respondent stated that their record retention period of sought for documents is 5 years. The respondent stated that they had tried to search out the record but could not trace the sought for record of the appellant.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application are satisfactory.

Decision:

7. No further intervention is required by the Commission.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
