ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 27.03.2015 seeking information regarding his service record, why his service book has not been sent to the concerned department, when his arrear would be released etc.
2. The CPIO response is not on record. The appellant filed first appeal on 04.05.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal on 09.06.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated he has not been provided the sought for information. The appellant stated that most of the reply to the asked for queries is 'information not available'. The appellant stated that his service record has not been sent since last two and half year. The appellant stated that his promotion process is affected because of non availability of service record in the office.

5. The respondent stated that they have replied to the appellant vide letter dated 18.04.2015. The respondent stated that the record was sent to the concerned office but it was returned for completing the shortcomings. The respondent stated that they will send the appellant's service record within next 15 days.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The respondent may resend a copy of the reply to the appellant.

Decision:

7. Respondent is directed to resend the reply to the appellant within 30 days of this order. The respondent is further advised to send the service record of the appellant as early as possible.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
