ORDER

Facts:

1. The complainant filed RTI application dated 05.09.2015 seeking information on 12 points regarding education criterion for the post of Sub Postmaster and Asst. Supdt. of Posts; education qualification of Sub Postmaster and Asst. Supdt. of Posts Renukoot, Shri Ghanshyam Patel etc.
2. The CPIO response is not on record. The complainant filed a complaint with the Commission on 21.03.2016 with a plea to provide information.

Hearing:

3. The complainant participated in the hearing personally. The respondent informed on telephone that he could not participate in the hearing at the changed time at 3:00 PM as he was stuck in the traffic. However, he was earlier present in the VC center at the scheduled time viz 12:30 PM.
4. The complainant stated that he has been given incomplete information. The complainant stated that he is not satisfied with the reply of the respondent. The complainant further stated that he has been denied information on flimsy

grounds. The complainant alleged that the Postal Deptt. has tortured by him by making false complaint against him with the police authorities. The complainant stated the two officials have been working in same post office since last 20 years and their education certificates have not been provided to him. He alleged that false educational certificates have been submitted by these people. The respondent through telephone informed the Commission that the sought for information has been provided to the complainant. The respondent stated that he has replied on 30.10.2015.

Discussion/ observation:

5. The complainant is still seeking information and hence the complaint may be treated as appeal.
6. The sought for information, except the educational certificates of the employees, can be provided to the appellant.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to provide information, in the context of the RTI application, to the appellant as stated in para 7 above within 30 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
