During the hearing the respondent PIO submitted that they had provided the requisite information vide their letter dated 17.03.2015 in connection with the RTI application dated 13.02.2015. The appellant submitted that he was not satisfied with the reply on point nos. 1 and 2 of the said RTI application. He further submitted that information provided on point nos. 3 and 4 was not in accordance with the information sought for by the appellant.

On perusal of the case record, it was seen that the reply provided on point nos. 1,2,4 is proper, the Commission did not agree with the appellant that the same was not in accordance with the information sought by him in the said RTI application. The revised reply on point no. 3 may again be provided to the appellant.

The respondent CPIO is directed to provide **revised** point wise reply on point no. 3) complete in all respects to the appellants, as available on record including true certified true copies of the documents e.g. note sheet, letters, correspondence etc e-mail free of charge u/s 7(6) of the RTI Act within 10 days of the receipt of the order.

A Compliance report with proof of despatch of the same to the appellant shall be submitted within 07 days thereafter to the Commission for record.

With the above direction, the appeal is disposed of.
