ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed several RTI applications dated 20.03.2015, 20.12.2014, 02.01.2015 seeking information regarding action taken on his letter dated 22-23/04/2014 with regard to dismissal of his departmental appeal by the Hon'ble High Court of MP.
2. The CPIO responded on 22.01.2015, 14.02.2015, 21.04.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 13.05.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 08.06.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 03.07.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that he had sent a letter/SLP dated 23.04.2014 by post to the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The appellant stated that he wanted to know the action taken on this letter. The appellant stated that he has not received any reply from the respondent and no information has been provided to him.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant has filed several RTI applications. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letters dated 22.01.2015, 14.02.2015 and 21.04.2015 was informed that he was advised vide their letter dated 03.06.2014 to file, if he so wishes, proper Special Leave Petition in form 28 as per Supreme Court Rules available on Court's website www.sci.nic.in. The respondent stated that the appellant letter dated 14.11.2014 was sent to Secretary, Supreme Court Legal Service Committee on 08.12.2014.

6. The respondent stated that the first appellate authority vide its order dated 08.06.2015 had disposed of the first appeal having concurred with the findings of the CPIO.

Discussion/ observation:

7. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

8. No action is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
