During the hearing the respondent CPIO submitted that they had provided the requisite reply vide their letters dated 22.04.2015, 05.05.2015 and 14.05.2015 in connection with the RTI application dated 07.03.2015.

On perusal of the case record, it was seen that information provided was just and proper except on point no. 5, of the said RTI application.

However, it was seen that information was provided after a period of one year which is deplorable. **The respondent CPIO is issued a warning to be more careful while dealing with RTI matters in future.**

**The registry of this bench is directed to send a copy of this order to Member (Traffic) and Chairman, Railway Board for taking necessary follow up action in the matter.**

The respondent CPIO is directed to provide point wise reply (on point no. 5) complete in all respects to the appellant as available on record (certified true copies of the documents) e.g. note sheet, letters, correspondence, e.mail etc free of charge u/s 7(6) of the RTI Act within 15 days of the receipt of the order.

The respondent CPIO is further directed to send a report containing the copy of the reply and the date of despatch of the same to the RTI appellant within 07 days thereafter to the Commission for record.

***With the above direction, the appeal is disposed of.***
