During the hearing the respondent CPIO submitted that they had provided the replies vide their letters dated 21.04.14 and 23.5.15 in connection with the RTI applications dated 20.04.2015 & 03.04.2014. He was intimated to send copies of the same to the Commission through e-mail for record.

After hearing the reply, the same were found to be satisfactory. The respondent CPIO also submitted that all dues of the appellant were since settled fully.
