During the hearing it was submitted by the respondent CPIO, Lucknow that information pertains to Fatehgarh and hence the same was transferred under section 6(3) of the RTI Act in December, 2013 itself. The reason for not furnishing the required information to the appellant was asked from the CPIO Fatehgarh Cantonment Board who attended the hearing in person. It was submitted by the CPIO, Fatehgarh that the said RTI application was transferred by the CPIO, Lucknow through their letter in the month of January, 2014 but the reason for non furnishing of the information to the appellant was not known to him.

Both the respondent CPIOs, ie of Lucknow and Fatehgarh **Shri R.P. Singh** and **Shri Onkar Singh should be** issued strict warning to refrain from such negligent act in future. **A copy of this order may be sent to the Controller of General Accounts for the required action in this regard.**

The appellant was not present to plead his case.

The CPIO, Fatehgarh **Shri Onkar Singh** is directed to provide information as available on record to the appellant within 7 days from the receipt of the order.

With the above direction, the appeal is disposed of.
