ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 19.03.2016 seeking information regarding the copy of BSNL order vide which it is necessary that a separate receipt of consultation charges must be issued by the doctor for the amount to be admissible for reimbursement; copy of BSNL order in which certain medicines, even if prescribed, by doctor are not eligible for reimbursement.
2. The response of CPIO is dated nil. The appellant filed first appeal dated 27.04.2016 with First Appellate Authority (FAA). The response of FAA is undated. The appellant filed second appeal on 08.07.2016 before the Commission on the ground that the information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent participated in the hearing in person.
4. The appellant stated the sought for information has not been provided to him. The appellant stated that he wants the rule/ order position on his queries.
5. The appellant stated that a reply was sent two times to the appellant but the envelopes were returned by the Department of Posts. On query from the Commission, the respondent stated that the appellant was informed that the 'documents are not available'. The respondent stated that rule/order position on both queries shall be furnished by him.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The respondent may take action as per para 5 above.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to take action as stated in para 5 above, within 15 days of receipt of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
