ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 26.02.2015 seeking information regarding the rule under which the appellant's letter dated 27.10.2014 was stopped and opened and certified copy of the investigation report etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 30.03.2015. The appellant filed first appeal dated 18.04.2015. The FAA responded on 18.05.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 12.08.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent participated in the hearing through video conferencing.
4. The appellant stated that he wants to know the rules that under which his Dak/Speed Post were opened by the respondents. The appellant stated that he has been provided misleading information.

The appellant stated that he has been provided only one inquiry report out of two inquiry reports. The appellant stated he has been provided uncertified copy.

5. The respondent stated that inquiry report available in the file has been provided to the appellant on 13.02.2017. The report inter alia covers the issue of opening of his Dak. The respondent stated that if any other inquiry report available in the record in this matter, they will provide to the appellant.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The respondent may provide any other Enquiry Report, if available in the record. Further, the respondent should provide a certified copy of the Enquiry Report already given to the appellant. The respondent may further, provide the rules with regard to opening the dak/speed posts etc. if any, available with them.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to take action as stated in para 6 above within 15 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
