ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 25.11.2014 seeking information on 9 points regarding the reasons for his frequent transfer, rule/power to overrule the standing orders, the copy of enquiry report pertaining to transfer and payment of transfer related grants along with reimbursement of bills in question, etc.

2. The CPIO responded on 22.12.2014, 25.05.2015. The appellant filed first appeal dated 15.02.2015 before the first appellate authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 31.03.2015. The appellant filed second appeal to the Commission on 18.09.2015 on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. Both the parties participated in the hearing through video conferencing.

4. The appellant stated that the respondent has not furnished the information pertaining to release of transfer grant to him and reasons for his frequent transfer orders. Further appellant stated that he has not been supplied information with regard to point nos. 4, 6 and 8. Point 4 relates to supply of

certain note sheets, point 6 and 8 relates to details of other officers who have been frequently transferred, and officers/staff who were paid transfer grant.

5. The appellant further stated that the respondent has not given him FAA order and the relevant enclosures along with the reply dated 25.05.2015.

6. The respondent stated that they do not maintain any consolidated record relating to transfer grant and transfer orders.

7. The respondent further stated that the required information on point nos. 3 and 8 are concerned with the Fatehpur Division and the reply received after referring the matter to Fatehpur Division has been enclosed along with the reply given to the appellant on 25.05.2015.

Discussion/ observation:

8. The respondent shall furnish the information on point nos. 4, 6 and 8 of the RTI application to the appellant within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of this order.

9. The respondent shall also supply to the appellant relevant note-sheets of files on which his transfer orders were processed within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of this order.

Decision:

10. The respondent is directed to take action as per paras 8 and 9 above.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
