**ORDER**

**Facts:**

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 14.08.2015 seeking certified copy of an investigation report sent by respondent to Director Posts; why his speed post letter was marked as unclaimed; and to specify the sources from which the respondent got the wrong address of the appellant recorded in respondent's letter dated 04.08.2015 etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 08.09.2015. The appellant filed first appeal dated 16.02.2015. The FAA responded on 09.10.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 09.11.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant and the respondent participated in the hearing.

4. The appellant stated that the desired information has not been provided to the appellant. The appellant stated that he wants to know the meaning of 'unclaimed' dak. The appellant stated that while he is receiving all his letters at his address, under what circumstances his speed post in question was returned with remarks 'unclaimed'.
5. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letter dated 08.09.2015 was informed that the inquiry was conducted and therein it has not been confirmed who made the remark 'unclaimed' on his speed post in question. The respondent stated that the appellant was asked to deposit Rs. 6 for copying charges of inquiry report but he did not deposit.
6. The appellant stated that he had deposited Rs. 6 already and informed the respondent, yet the enquiry report in the matter has not been given to him.

**Discussion/ observation:**

7. The copy of inquiry report should be provided to the appellant free of cost.

**Decision:**

8. The respondent is directed to provide inquiry report to the appellant, free of cost, within 15 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
