ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 10.07.2014 seeking information regarding deputation period of appellant during the period from 1993 to 2011 and name of the post office and the period of outstation SPM/PM etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 30.07.2014. The appellant filed first appeal dated 02.09.2014. The FAA responded on 27.05.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 27.08.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. Appellant was absent. Respondent participated in the hearing through video conferencing.
4. Respondent referred to RTI application dated 10.07.2014 and stated that vide their letter dated 30.07.2014 they have informed the

appellant that information sought in his RTI application is not available and therefore, sought information cannot be provided.

5. Respondent further stated that as per their retention policy they keep such records for 3 years and after that they destroy it.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The Commission observed that information has not been provided to the appellant by the respondent. Commission further observed that respondent shall provide the information sought to the appellant within 30 days after the receipt of this order. Alternately, they should reply to the appellant that they have destroyed the records as per their record retention policy.

Decision:

7. Respondent is directed to take action as para 6 above within 30 days after the receipt of this order. The matter may be put up for hearing on compliance by Deputy Registrar after 30 days.
The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
