ORDER

1. Shri Himanshu filed an application dated 01.11.2014 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Prime Minister's Office (PMO) seeking information on seven points regarding Constable (GD) Examination, 2011 held by Staff Selection Commission (SSC) on 05.06.2011. The CPIO, PMO vide letter dated 10.11.2014 transferred the RTI application to Department of Personnel and Training (DOPT).

2. The appellant filed a second appeal dated 20.01.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that he has not been provided any information by the CPIO and the First Appellate Authority (FAA).

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri Himanshu was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Gopinath Nayak, Under Secretary (C 1/2), Staff Selection Commission(SSC) was present in person.

4. The respondent, DoPT in his written submission dated 30.08.2016 submitted that the RTI application dated 01.11.2014 was transferred to the CPIO, SSC HQ vide letter dated 13.11.2014 under intimation to the appellant as the subject matter pertained to SSC.

5. The respondent SSC informed the Commission that they have vide letter dated 02.09.2016 provided the requisite information to the appellant.

Decision:

6. The Commission, after hearing the submissions of the respondent and perusing the records, observes that due information has been provided to the appellant. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

7. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of
