ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 09.06.2015 seeking certified copy of letter/order concerning relieving arrangement in place of the official who was suspended vide memo no. B- 158 dated 17.07.1996 and copy of the delivery receipt signed by concerned suspended official etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 10.07.2015 and 30.07.2015. The appellant filed first appeal dated 15.07.2015. The FAA responded on 07.10.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 27.10.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. Both appellant and respondent participated in the hearing through video conferencing.

4. Appellant stated that he had filed RTI Application on 09.06.2015 and received reply from the CPIO on 10.07.2015 and 30.07.2015. But information was not provided.
5. Respondent stated that they have provided the information to the appellant vide CPIO reply dated 10.07.2015 to the appellant that the appellant's file is not traceable in their office.
6. Respondent further stated that the file of the appellant had gone to the higher authority i.e. Chief Post Master of General, Patna for the necessary action.

Discussion/ observation:

7. The Commission observed that full information has not been provided to the appellant by the respondent. Commission further observed that respondent should trace out the file and provide the remainder information to the appellant and send compliance report to the Commission within 30 days.

Decision:

8. The respondent is directed to take action as per para 7 above.
9. The matter may be put up again by Deputy Registrar after 30 days. The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
