## **FACTS:**

2. The appellant is asking information about list of students along with father's names for 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> standard for the session 2014-15. The CPIO denied the information stating it was personal information under Section 8 (1) (j). The appellant approached the Commission.

## **Decision :**

3. The public authority rejected the request under privacy clause of Section 8(1)(g) of RTI Act. The Appellant says he required this information to prove a big business going on in private and non affiliated schools with the support of CBSE. The PIO could have separated mobile numbers, address and other personal details and should have given name, father's name, and area of residence, because that was being sought in public interest.

4. The Commission directs the CBSE to provide the name, father's name, area of residence like name of village or colony without giving details of address, mobile number, etc of students of 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> standard 2014-15 of Modern

Public School, Khatoli, UP, within 20 days from the date of receipt of this order. The Commission also directs the respondent authority to provide action taken report on the complaint filed by the appellant on 7-11-2015, within 20 days from the date of receipt of this order.

5. The Commission directs the PIO, CBSE and Regional Director, Mr. Ranbir Singh and Secretary, Headquarters of CBSE, New Delhi to inquire into the complaint of appellant that some of the students who got admitted in non-CBSE affiliated schools were allowed to appear in examinations conducted by CBSE schools for certification, while it was mandatory to attend classes and examinations only in CBSE schools, and submit report within 60 days from date of receipt of this order. Disposed of.
