The Commission took serious note of the respondent/representative of respondent's absence in the hearing despite valid and timely notice. The respondent is advised to be more sincere in attending CIC hearings in future.

During the hearing the appellant submitted that she did not get complete information in respect of her abovementioned RTI application.

On perusal of the case record, it is that seen that respondent CPIO had claimed exemption u/s 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act. The respondent CPIO however followed the procedure prescribed under Section 11 of the RTI Act and on the basis of the objection of the concerned third party, both the CPIO and FAA denied the said information to the appellant. It is observed that Section 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act was correctly invoked by the CPIO in this case and the Commission finds no infirmity in the respondent's reply to the appellant.

With the above observation, the appeal is disposed of.
