ORDER

1. Shri Shrish Kumar Garg filed an application dated 22.05.2014 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Central Information Commission (CIC) seeking information on ten points regarding uploading of the decisions of the CIC.

2. The appellant filed the second appeal dated 23.08.2014 before the Commission on the grounds that he has been provided incomplete and

misleading information by the CPIO and the First Appellant Authority (FAA) has also not provided any information.

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri Shrish Kumar Garg was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Sushil Kumar, Dy. Secretary (Admin.), CIC was present in person.

4. The respondent submitted that the information sought was provided to the appellant vide letter dated 17.06.2014. The respondent further submitted that the FAA vide his order dated 09.10.2014 had directed the CPIO to provide information on point no. 3 of the RTI application to the appellant. The respondent further submitted that in compliance with the order of the FAA, information on point no. 3 of the RTI application has been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 18.11.2014. Hence, no further information remains to be provided to the appellant.

Decision:

5. The Commission, after hearing the respondent and perusing the records, observes that due information has been provided to the appellant by the respondent. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

6. With the above observation, the appeal is disposed of.
