Information sought:

The appellant had sought information on following 7 points:

1. Details relating to illegal construction for the last 15 years.
2. Action taken against the above.
3. Copy of the order for demolition of the above.
4. Number of illegal construction sealed in the last 15 years with details.
5. Copy of the order/rule for such demolition.
6. Copy of the rule/order for revoking the seal.
7. Copy of the legal action taken against illegal constructions.

Grounds for Second Appeal

The CPIO did not provide the desired information.

Order

During the hearing the representative of the appellant submitted that he got complete information on points 1 to 5 in connection with his RTI application dated 10.10.2013. In regard to the information on the rest of the points i.e. on point no. 6, wrong information was provided and on point no. 7 incomplete information was provided. The representative of the appellant pressed for levying of penalty on the then CPIO.

On perusal of the case record, it is seen that point wise complete information had been furnished to the appellant on 10th December, 2013 and the representative of the appellant himself agreed that information on point nos 1 to 5, was satisfactory, only on point 6 he contested the correctness of the information furnished to the appellant. The Commission accordingly finds it fit to direct the CPIO to give an attested copy of the information on point no. 6 to the appellant within 21 days of the receipt of this order with copy endorsed to the Commission for record. No further action is required. *The matter is closed.*
