ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed several RTI applications dated 11.04.2011, 12.02.2014 seeking information on three points in respect of SLP (Civil) No. 3990 of 2011 such as copy of his identity proof, gate pass issued on 07.03.2011, copy of Vakalatnama of the lawyer who was heard on his behalf on 07.03.2011 and seeking status of his various letters etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 13.05.2011, 10.03.2014. The appellant filed first appeal with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 28.04.2014. The appellant filed second appeal on 25.09.2014 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The respondent participated in the hearing personally. The appellant did not participate in the hearing.
4. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letter dated 13.05.2011 was informed that no identity proof is available in the computer record dated 07.03.2011 at reception and no entry pass has been issued. The certified copies of the judicial record/judgement /orders of the Hon'ble Court can be

obtained by moving an application to the Registrar (Copying), Supreme Court of India under XII, Supreme Court Rules, 1966 on payment of prescribed fee and charges. These Rules are available on the Supreme Court website www.supremecourtfindia.nic.in.

5. The respondent stated that the matter related to the appellant's RTI application dated 12.02.2014 has been disposed of by this Commission vide order CIC/RM/C/2014/000306/Vs dated 29.10.2015.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

7. No action is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
