Order

1. Shri Bodh Krishna Thakur filed an application dated 24.12.2014 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT) seeking information on four points pertaining to his complaint sent by e-mail to the Secretary, DoPT under Section 4 and 11 of the Whistle Blowers Act, 2011 including (1) attested copy of detailed action taken report of DoPT on his said complaint and (2) final decision taken by the DoPT on this complaint and (3) attested copy of correspondence made and received by the DoPT in the matter.

2. Shri Bodh Krishna Thakur filed a complaint dated 05.09.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that the CPIO did not provide the information sought by him despite the First Appellate Authority (FAA)'s Order to provide the information. The complainant requested the Commission to direct the concerned CPIO to provide the information sought by him.

Hearing:

3. The complainant Shri Bodh Krishna Thakur was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri L.P. Sharma, Under Secretary, DOPT was present in person.

4. The respondent submitted that in compliance with the FAA's order dated 29.05.2015 information was provided to the appellant vide letter dated 15.09.2015.

Decision:

5. The Commission, after hearing both the parties and perusing the records, observes that due information has been provided to the appellant. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

6. With the above observations, the complaint is disposed of.

7. Copy of decision be given free of cost to the parties.
