ORDER

1. Shri Sandeep Ishwar Singh Rana filed an application dated 08.02.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Staff Selection Commission (SSC) seeking information on two points pertaining to Recruitment of Sub-Inspector in Delhi Police and Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs), in CISF Examination - 2014, including the marks scored by him.

2. The appellant filed a second appeal dated 14.04.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that he has not been provided any information.

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri Sandeep Ishwar Singh Rana attended the hearing through video conferencing. The respondent Shri R. Thakur, Under Secretary, SSC was present in person.

4. The appellant submitted that the respondent had informed that the marks for Paper-II are available on the website of the SSC. However, the same is not available on the website. The appellant further submitted that he had applied for the change of the examination center from Gorakhpur to Chandigarh and the same was approved by the SSC vide letter dated 01.10.2014. The appellant further stated that he had qualified the medical examination which he undertook at the Group Centre, CRPF, Chandigarh. The documents relating to the change of examination center as well as medical examination were also produced by the appellant.

5. The respondent submitted that the appellant was informed vide letter dated 16.03.2015 that since the result of PST and Medical Examination is not available with the undersigned, therefore, information sought by him cannot be furnished. The respondent further submitted that Paper-II of only those candidates are evaluated who qualify the medical examination. The respondent further submitted that Medical Examination for Paper-I qualified candidates was conducted at the designated centers at Allahabad, Lucknow, Bareilly, Gorakhpur, Mokamaghat, West Champaran, Mujaffarpur and Hazaribagh and as per the record of SSC, the appellant was absent in the medical examination. Therefore, Paper-II of the appellant was not evaluated.

Decision:

6. The Commission, after hearing both the parties and perusing the records, observes that information on the basis of available records has been provided to the appellant by the respondent. The Commission, further observes that since the appellant had appeared in the medical examination at Chandigarh with prior permission of SSC, he may approach the SSC for redressal of his grievances.

7. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
