Information sought :

Jha, process of confirming waiting tickets and designation of the officer responsible for discharging such responsibilities, role of Shri Premchand Jha in ticket reservation in the Central Railway and other related information.

Grounds for Second Appeal

Order

During the hearing the respondent CPIO submitted that they had provided the requisite reply vide their letter dated 28.08.14 in connection with the RTI application dated 02.08.2014. As the same was not available in the case file, the respondent APIO was instructed to send the same through e-mail for the record of the Commission.

The appellant was not present to challenge the contention of the respondent PIO.

On perusal of the case record, it is seen that information provided was deficient in respect of point nos. 5, 4 and 2 of the above stated RTI application. The respondent is directed to check the record and ensure that the answer already provided to the appellant was correct & complete in all respects.

The respondent CPIO is directed to provide point wise reply complete in all respects to the appellant in respect of point nos. 4 and 5 of the abovementioned RTI application.

The entire action is to be completed within one month of the receipt of the order.

With the above direction, the appeal is disposed of.
