ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 19.05.2015 seeking information on 26 points regarding: copy of calculation sheet giving details of appellant's retirement benefits; copies of show cause notice(s) stated to have been issued to the appellant; copy of letter addressed to the appellant, if any, giving intimation that a sum of Rs. 2,44,784/- will be recovered from his Dearness relief, etc.

2. The response of CPIO is not on record. The appellant filed first appeal dated 16.07.2015, with First Appellate Authority (FAA). The response of FAA is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal on 30.09.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The respondent participated in the hearing. The appellant did not participate in the hearing.

4. The respondent stated that the appellant has been replied to vide letter dated 02.06.2015 and 06.11.2015. The respondent stated that the available information has been provided to the appellant. The respondent stated that they had to collect information from the various departments therefore; they could not provide information with initial reply. The respondent stated that a CAT case was filed by the appellant which has been decided and they are taking legal opinion for further action.

Discussion/ observation:

5. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory. The information has been provided to the appellant.

Decision:

6. No action is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
