ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 21.08.2014 seeking certified copy of the objection raised on passport file no GZ1067993763414 and name and designation of the officials who made objection etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 19.09.2014. The appellant filed first appeal dated 25.09.2014. The response of FAA is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal on 17.11.2014 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. Appellant was represented by Shri Vimal who participated in the hearing through video conferencing. Respondent was represented through his counsel, who was personally present in the hearing.

4. Appellant stated that he had filed RTI Application on 21.08.2014 and received reply from the CPIO on 19.09.2014 but information was not satisfactory. He filed First Appeal on 25.09.2014 but FAA has not disposed off this appeal.
5. Appellant further stated that respondent have provided the file but there was no record of any objection in that. Appellant further stated that he did not ask any information which attracts section 8 of the RTI Act.
6. Respondent stated that they have provided all information that was in their file.

Discussion/ observation:

7. The Commission observed that information provided by respondent has been challenged by the appellant in as much that no record of any objection is stated to be on the copy of file given to her.

Decision:

8. Respondent is directed to produce the relevant original passport application file before the Commission on next date of the hearing of this case. Deputy Registrar may fix the case after 15 days.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
