**Information sought:**

The appellant is aggrieved as he did not receive his 16 A FORM. Therefore, he wanted to know the reason for not obtaining the above FORM, he had also sought copy of the acknowledgement, name of officers responsible for such delay, address to which the above FORM was sent, details of the FAA etc.

The CPIO did not provide the desired information.

## **Order**

During the hearing the respondent CPIO submitted that reply was filed vide their letter dated 15.04.2014 in connection with RTI application dated 20.03.2014. On perusal of the record, it is seen that the same was not available in the case file. The respondent CPIO was asked to read it over the VC facility and send the same through e-mail for Commission's record.

The appellant submitted that the said letter was not received by him. The respondent CPIO was directed to send a copy of the letter dated 15.04.2014 to the appellant within 7 days to enable the appellant to send the details asked for in the letter dated 15.04.2014.

The respondent CPIO is also directed to provide the deficient information in regard to 16 A Form to the appellant thereafter in no case beyond a period of 10 days after the receipt of complete details from the applicant as asked for in the letter dated 15.04.2014. The entire operation shall be completed within one month from the receipt of the order. The respondent should also send an action taken report to the Commission after the expiry of the above mentioned period.

CPIO may note that non-compliance of this order may lead to penal action u/s 20(1) of the RTI Act.

***With the above direction, the appeal is disposed of.***
