### **Information sought**

This matter concerns an RTI application filed by the Appellant, seeking information regarding the designation, salary, employee code number, duration of working, transfer etc. of her husband Shri Ram Niwas Chain Singh, who was an employee of the bank.

### **The CPIO reply**

The CPIO responded point-wise to the RTI application.

### **Grounds of the First Appeal**

No information provided.

### **Order of the First Appellate Authority**

The FAA directed the CPIO to provide a copy of the reply dated 23.9.2015 again to the Appellant.

### **Grounds of the Second Appeal**

Not satisfied with the information provided by the Respondents.

### **Relevant facts emerging during the Hearing, Discussion and Decision**

The Appellant was not present in spite of a written notice having been sent to her. We have perused the records placed before us. With reference to point No. 7 of the RTI application, the CPIO is directed to inform the Appellant about the grounds of termination of services of her husband, Shri Ram Niwas Chain Singh in 2003 and provide her a copy of the termination order, if available on record. The CPIO should comply with our above directive, within twenty days of the receipt of this order, under intimation to the Commission. The information should be provided free of charge. We do not consider it necessary to intervene in respect of the remaining points of the RTI application.

2. With the above directions and observations, the appeal is disposed of.
3. Copies of this order be given free of cost to the parties.
