Information sought

This matter concerns an RTI application filed by the Complainant, seeking information on seventeen points regarding request for proposal of the Respondents for setting up feed outlet/shop at “Auto Care Centre” BKC, Bandra (East) and related issues.

The CPIO reply

The CPIO vide letter dated 18.8.2015 responded point wise to the RTI application dated 28.7.2015.

Grounds of complaint to the CIC

Not satisfied with reply given by the CPIO on point Nos. 4, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16 & 17 of the RTI application dated 28.7.2015.

Relevant facts emerging during the Hearing, Discussion and Decision

The Complainant was not present in spite of a written notice having been sent to him. The notice for the hearing sent at his address has been returned by the postal authorities with the notation 'left'.

2. In his complaint to the Commission, the Complainant had objected to the response of the Respondents to points No. 4, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16 and 17 of his RTI application. The Respondents reiterated the reply of the CPIO. With regard to points No. 11 and 12, they stated that since the intimation regarding the rescheduled date was not received by bidders, the bid was cancelled, offers were invited again and the Complainant was also given an opportunity to make an offer.

3. In the light of the submissions made by the Respondents, we see no ground to interfere with the reply of the CPIO to the points of the RTI application listed above.

4. With the above observations, the complaint is disposed of.
