Information sought and background of the case:

The complainant vide RTI application dated 27.02.2016 sought information under 8 points regarding daily progress made in respect of recruitment of JE A/c & R, ever since the result has been received by Recruitment Cell. CPIO vide letter dated 27.02.2016 transferred the RTI application to Sr. Administrative Officer/CPIO Recruitment Cell. The complainant preferred first appeal but the same remained unheard. Feeling aggrieved the complainant approached the Commission.

Relevant facts emerging during hearing:

The appellant states that information sought has not been provided till date. Narrating the background of the case the appellant states that he had appeared for the examination for selection of JEs, and was even selected. However, since his file was kept pending by the authorities concerned, he

never received the appointment letter. Hence he filed the RTI application and enquired about the movement of files.

A detailed submission dated 19.01.2017 has been submitted by the Respondent by which it has been envisaged that though points 3 to 8 of the RTI application were duly responded, the points 1 & 2 could not be responded since the file containing the relevant information was under process. The Respondent further averred that the reason behind non issuance of appointment letter to the appellant was because though he alongwith the other successful candidate possessed requisite degrees (Appellant was a qualified B. Tech-Mechanical & Automation Engineer), but it was essential that the candidates should be qualified in the specialised course in Refrigeration and Airconditioning from a recognised Polytechnic/Institute. The appellant had not submitted any documents in this regard, establishing that he possessed the requisite qualification. Hence, his candidature could not be considered for the post of Jr. Engineer (AC & Refrigeration). A copy of the Recruitment Rules for the post of Junior Engineer (A/C & Refrigeration) has been placed on record and it conforms to the averments of the Respondent. The Respondent further added that after receipt of the representations from the two successful but rejected candidates, the matter has now been taken up and referred to the appropriate authority for consideration.

Decision:

After hearing submissions of parties and perusal of record, the Commission directs the Respondent to furnish a Revised Reply within two weeks of receipt of this order, to the appellant providing the current position with respect to the selection/consideration of the candidature of the appellant.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
