**ORDER**

1. Shri Hemant Singh filed an application dated 07.04.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the CPIO, Department of Personnel & Training seeking information on three points pertaining to the kind of petty job one Shri Sandeep Rana was performing for meeting his daily

expenses as recorded in the Minutes and Noting at the time of grant of approval for compassionate appointment and whether the Committee verified the claim by visiting his house/residence.

**2.** Shri Hemant Singh filed a second appeal dated 07.07.2015 on the grounds that complete information has not been provided to him and requested the Commission to direct the concerned CPIO to provide complete information as sought by him.

**Hearing:**

**3.** Both the appellant Shri Hemant Singh and the respondent Shri Kulbhushan Malhotra, Under Secretary and CPIO, DOPT was present in person.

**4.** The appellant submitted that he had sought further details about the nature of “petty job” in which Shri Sandeep Rana S/o Shri Rashpal Singh was engaged. However, no additional information in this regard has been provided to him.

**5.** The respondent submitted that information as available was provided to the appellant vide letter dated 27.04.2015. The appellant was informed that that the Committee constituted for appointments on compassionate grounds had in its report stated that the “elder son (of Shri Rashpal Singh) is engaged in petty jobs to meet the daily expenses”. The respondent further submitted that a copy of the report was also provided to the appellant.

**Decision:**

**6.** The Commission, after hearing the submissions of both the parties and perusing the records, observes that the due information has been provided to the appellant by the respondent. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

7. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
