ORDER

1. Shri Tejvir Singh filed an application dated 01.02.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) seeking inspection of all documents and files relevant to the results of the Written Examination & Shorthand Test of Service Category VI of the Combined S.Os/Stenos Gr.B/Gr.I Limited Departmental Examination – 2001 held in December,

2001, copies of documents if required after inspection, and intimate date, time and venue for inspection.

2. Shri Tejvir Singh filed a second appeal dated 24.04.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that both the CPIO and the First Appellate Authority (FAA) have not provided the information sought by him taking exemption under Section 8(1)(d), (g) & (j) of the RTI Act. The appellant requested the Commission to direct the CPIO and the FAA, UPSC to fix a date, time & venue to inspect/provide copies, if required, of the files and documents relevant, hiding the portion of names and designation mentioned in papers/files which reveal an identity regarding the results of the written examination and shorthand test of service category VI of the Combined S.Os/Stenos (Gr.B/Gr.I) Limited Departmental Competitive Examination-2001.

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri Tejvir Singh was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Shakti Shamsher, Under Secretary, UPSC was present in person.

4. The respondent submitted that the second appeal in an identical matter has already been heard and disposed of by the Commission vide Decision No. CIC/CC/A/2015/003532/SB dated 22.08.2016.

Decision:

5. The Commission, observes that an identical matter has already been heard and disposed of by the Commission vide Decision No. CIC/CC/A/2015/003532/SB dated 22.08.2016. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

6. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
