ORDER

1. Shri Ashok Kumar filed an application dated 11.04.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) seeking information on four points regarding the Combined S.Os/Stenos Gr.B/Gr.I Limited Departmental Examination – 2004 held in December, 2004, including (a) marks obtained by him (Roll No. 646 Service Categories VI & IX) in Written

Examination subject-wise in respect of both service categories VI & IX and (b) marks/percentage obtained by him in Shorthand Test in Service Category VI.

2. Shri Ashok Kumar filed a second appeal dated 14.06.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that both the CPIO and the First Appellate Authority (FAA) have not provided the information sought by him. The appellant requested the Commission to direct the CPIO and the FAA, UPSC to provide the information sought for.

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri Ashok Kumar was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Shakti Shamsher, Under Secretary, UPSC was present in person.

4. The respondent submitted that the appellant was informed vide letter dated 06.05.2013 that the marks obtained by the candidates were made available on the Commission's website after the declarations of the final result of the Combined S.Os/Stenos Gr.B/Gr.I Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) – 2004. The appellant was also informed that he had not qualified in the shorthand test. The respondent further submitted that the appellant was also informed vide letter dated 20.10.2016 about the marks obtained by him in the written examination/shorthand test of the Combined S.Os/Stenos Gr.B/Gr.I LDCE – 2004.

Decision:

5. The Commission, after hearing both the parties and perusing the records, observes that due information has been provided to the appellant. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

6. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
