Information sought:

The applicant had sought information on 17 points relating to PIO, Railways.

Grounds for Complaint:

The CPIO has not provided the desired information.

Order

Complainant : Absent

Respondent : APIO, Shri Katrasen with other PIOs

On perusal of the case record, it was seen that the applicant is desirous of obtaining information but had inadvertently filed the case to the CIC u/s 18 instead of under section 19 of the RTI Act.

With the concurrence of both the parties the Commission treated this case as appeal u/s 19(3) of the Act instead of one as a complaint case u/s 18 of the same Act.

The applicant was not present to plead his case. The reply furnished was not proper.

The respondent CPIO, Guntakal is directed to provide point wise reply complete in all respects to the appellant as available on record including certified true copies of the documents e.g. note sheet, letters, correspondence, e-mail etc. free of charge u/s 7(6) of the RTI Act within 30 days of the receipt of the order.

The respondent CPIO is further directed to send a compliance report containing the copy of the reply and the despatch details of the same to the appellant within 07 days thereafter to the Commission for record.

With the above direction, the case is disposed of.
