**ORDER**

1. Shri Asim Kumar Das filed an application dated 25.08.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) with the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO)/Assistant Commissioner, Central Excise, Bankura Division, Bankura on thirteen points with reference to and in relation to office letter No. V(9)1/CON/BNKD/2015/01(C) dated 11.08.2015 addressed to him pertaining to order dated 06.08.2015 of the Commissioner, Customs, Central Excise &

Service Tax, Durgapur Commissionerate, including (1) whether the said order has been communicated to the CPIO/his office of of Bankura Central Excise Division in Bankura through official letter under signature of the Commissioner or in any other mode of unofficial nature and (2) file No. & dispatch serial No. along with date of dispatch as appeared in the said official letter from Commissioner, Customs, Central Excise & Service Tax, Durgapur Commissionerate.

2. Shri Asim Kumar Das filed a complaint dated 06.10.2015 on the grounds that the CPIO stopped payment of salary of the complainant since August, 2015 referring to the said order dated 06.08.2015 of the Commissionerate, Customs, Central Excise & Service Tax, Durgapur Commissionerate without serving a copy of the said order to the complainant while issuing a letter dated 11.08.2015 thus violating the principles of natural justice.

**Hearing:**

3. Both the parties were absent despite notice.

**Decision:**

4. The Commission, after perusing the records observes that a reply to the appellant's RTI application was sent vide letter dated 24.09.2015. The Commission also notes that information as available on records was provided to the appellant.

5. With the above observations, the complaint is disposed of.
