ORDER

Facts:

1. The complainant filed RTI application dated 19.01.2015 and 14.11.2014 seeking copies of Kisan Vikas Patras (KVP) issued in February, 2006 in his name.
2. The CPIO response is not on record. The first appeal and first appellate authority's response is not on record. The complainant filed a complaint with the Commission on 13.02.2015 with a plea to take necessary action.

Hearing:

3. The complainant participated in the hearing through VC. The respondent participated in the hearing on telephone.
4. The complainant stated that his Kisan Vikas Patras (KVPs) have been lost. The complaint stated that he wants to know the name of the issuing post office so that he can complete the formalities relating to missing KVPs and get the payment. The complainant stated that the KVPs were issued on 11.02.2006 and matured on 11.09.2014. The complainant stated that he has provided the

registration number and issue date to the respondent several time. However, they have not provided him the name and details of the KVPs issuing post office.

5. The respondent stated that the complainant had not provided them the registration number and issuing date of KVPs. The respondent stated that without having these detail they are not in position to provide the name and details of the KVP issuing post office. The respondent stated that complaint has been replied to on 12.12.2014. The respondent read out the reply during the hearing.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The complainant is still pursuing for information, thus the complaint can be treated as appeal.

7. The respondent should contact complainant on his mobile no. 9450165952 and ascertain the registration number and issue date of KVPs. The complainant should provide the information on missing KVPs within 15 days.

Decision:

8. The respondent is directed to take action as per para 7 above, within 15 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
