ORDER

Facts:

1. The complainant filed RTI application dated 18.02.2013 seeking information on 11 points regarding marks obtained by her son in the Probationary Officer examination conducted by the IBPS and related matters.
2. The PIO response, first appeal and the FAA response are not on record. The complainant filed a complaint on 04.04.2013 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to her.

Hearing:

3. The complainant did not participate in the hearing. Mr. Dattatray Vyas (Advocate) represented the respondent in person.
4. The respondent stated that they have relied upon this Commission's decision No. CIC/DS/A/2011/000802 dated 04.09.2017. The respondent stated that the Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) does not come under purview of the RTI Act as it is not a 'public authority' under section 2(h) of the RTI Act, 2005.

Discussion/ observation:

5. The Commission is of the view that this Commission vide decision No. CIC/DS/A/2011/000802 dated 04.09.2017 held that the IBPS is not a 'public authority' under section 2(h) of the RTI Act. Hence, it does not come under the purview of the RTI Act.

Decision:

6. No intervention is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

The complaint is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
