Information Sought:

The Appellant had sought for information regarding action taken on application dated 10.09.2008 for 'pension for widow' from the PIO, Dy. Director, Social Welfare Department, North-East Distt, Samskar Ashram, Dilsad Garden, Delhi-95.

The details of information sought by the appellant are following:

1. Daily wise report of action taken on my application dated 10.09.2008 for 'pension for widow'.
2. Name of officers who had the application and how long they had and what action they took.
3. Name of officers and their post that had to take action but not did so.
4. What will action be taken on them and how long it takes?
5. In how many days will action be taken on my application?

The reply of PIO:

Not mentioned.

The First Appellate Authority ordered:

The first appellate authority, Department of Women & Child Development Govt of NCT of Delhi, 1, Canning Lane, K.G. Marg, New Delhi directed that the information be provided by JD (FAS) to the appellant within fifteen days of the receipt of this order.

Relevant Facts emerging during Hearing:

The following were present:

Appellant : Absent

Respondent : Mr. P.P.Dhal, Joint Director

The PIO shows that he has given the information as well as ensured that the pension remitted to the appellant. The Commission directs the public authority to ensure that names and addresses of people who apply for the various pension schemes are put up on the website every fortnight. The details of those who have been given the pension and those who have been rejected should also be put up on the website. The Commission directs the Secretary Social Welfare and Women and Child Development to ensure this before 15 July 2009. The Secretary Social Welfare and Women and Child Development will send a compliance report to the Commission before 30 July 2009.

Decision:

The Appeal is allowed.

The information has been provided to the appellant.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.

Any information in compliance with this order will be provided free of cost as per section 7(6) of RTI, Act, 2005.
