**ORDER**

1. Shri Jai Narayan Prasad filed an application dated 11.06.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Economic Offence Wing (EOW) (Crime Branch), Delhi Police

seeking information on four points pertaining to action taken on a complaint dated 06.05.2015.

**2.** The appellant filed a second appeal dated 06.10.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that he has not been provided any information either from the CPIO or FAA, EOW.

**Hearing:**

**3.** The appellant Shri Jai Narayan Prasad was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Vikram Singh Rana, ACP, Delhi Police was present in person.

**4.** The respondent submitted that since the complaint of the appellant dated 06.05.2015 relates to State of Bihar, therefore, the same was transferred to SSP, Poornia, Bihar on 04.06.2015. The respondent further submitted that since the complaint was transferred to the State of Bihar, therefore, the RTI application as well as the first appeal was also transferred under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act to the SSP, Poornia, Bihar vide letters dated 02.07.2015 and 31.08.2015 respectively.

**Decision:**

**5.** The Commission, after hearing the submissions of the respondent and perusing the records, observes that the information sought pertains to the State Government of Bihar to which the RTI application as well as the first appeal of the appellant has already been transferred by the respondent. Therefore, the present matter is beyond the jurisdiction of the Commission. Hence, no intervention of the Commission is required in the matter.

**6.** With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
