**ORDER**

**Facts:**

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 05.04.2016 seeking information regarding the action taken on his letters dated 17.03.2016, 22.02.2016, 14.03.2016 and 16.10.2015.
2. The response of CPIO is not on record. The appellant filed the first appeal dated 11.04.2016 with First Appellate Authority (FAA). The response of FAA of respondent is not on record. The appellant filed his second appeal on 13.05.2016 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided.

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that he has not been provided the information with regard to his letter dated 17.03.2016 which was addressed to Hon'ble Prime Minister Office. The appellant stated that he had made representation regarding 'save and educate the girl child'.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letter dated 04.10.2016 was informed that his letter dated 17.03.2016 has been forwarded to the DoPT (Department of Personnel and Training) vide Id. No. PMOPG/D/2016/0277557 dated 23.09.2016 for further appropriate action. The appellant further explained that the appellant had sent the copy of said letter dated 17.03.2016 along with the first appeal. The appellant stated that they have treated the copy of that letter as grievance and forwarded the same to the DoPT and the appellant was advised that he may see the action taken on his grievance on [www.pgportal.gov.in](http://www.pgportal.gov.in).

**Discussion/ observation:**

6. The appellant can see the action taken on his letter at given web portal. The available information has been given to the appellant.

**Decision:**

7. No action is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
