ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 02.12.2015 seeking information on his complaint regarding illegal possession of his land which was filed in May 2008 and 27.01.2011. The information sought included copy of first page of the complaint, reply of the President secretariat and report/notings, statements of Mr. Khemchand and Mr. Jaipal etc.

2. The CPIO responded on 31.12.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 21.01.2016 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 29.02.2016. The appellant filed second appeal on 16.06.2016 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant through authorised representative and the respondent participated in the hearing personally.

4. The appellant stated that he had made complaint regarding unauthorised possession of their land. The appellant stated that the complaint was forwarded to the Chief Secretary for appropriate action. The appellant stated that he is seeking a copy of the report received from the SDM.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letter dated 31.12.2015 was informed that his grievance was forwarded to the Chief Secretary, Delhi vide letter dated P2/E/1131 and P2/C/1808110088 dated 16.05.2008 and 18.02.2011 for appropriate action and no report has been received from Government of Delhi.

6. The respondent stated that the first appellate authority vide its order dated 29.02.2016 had disposed of the first appeal having concurred with the findings of the CPIO.

Discussion/ observation:

7. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

8. No action is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

9. The Chief Secretary, Government of Delhi is directed to communicate to the appellant the action taken on his aforesaid complaint forwarded by the President secretariat vide letter dated P2/E/1131 and P2/C/1808110088 dated 16.05.2008 within 30 days.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
